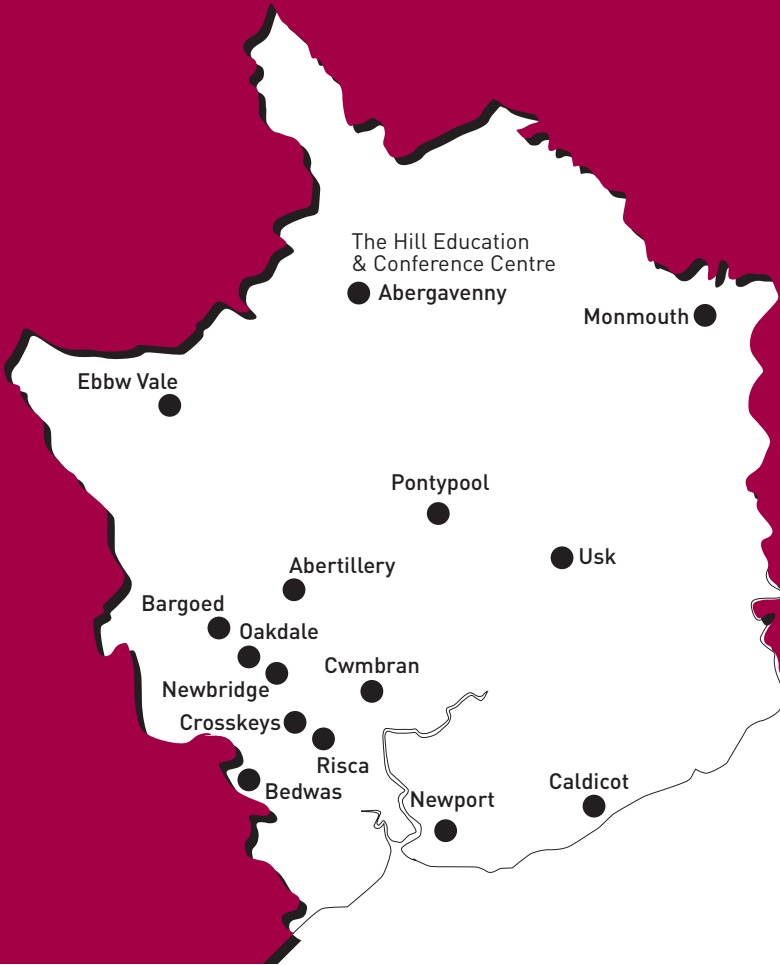

Welsh for Adults Examinations

The WJEC provides 4 qualifications specifically aimed at adults who are learning Welsh. The name of this series of qualifications is 'Defnyddio'r Gymraeg' or 'The Use of Welsh'. Candidates are given the opportunity

to show their ability in four skills: Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing, on four levels. The qualifications can be attained by sitting tests on specific days. The exams are open to adults who have learnt Welsh as a second language or who are learning at present. There is no requirement to be in a specific class to sit the exams, nor to have sat the lower examinations first. The qualifications are suited to people learning in evening or day classes, on intensive courses or on courses in the workplace.



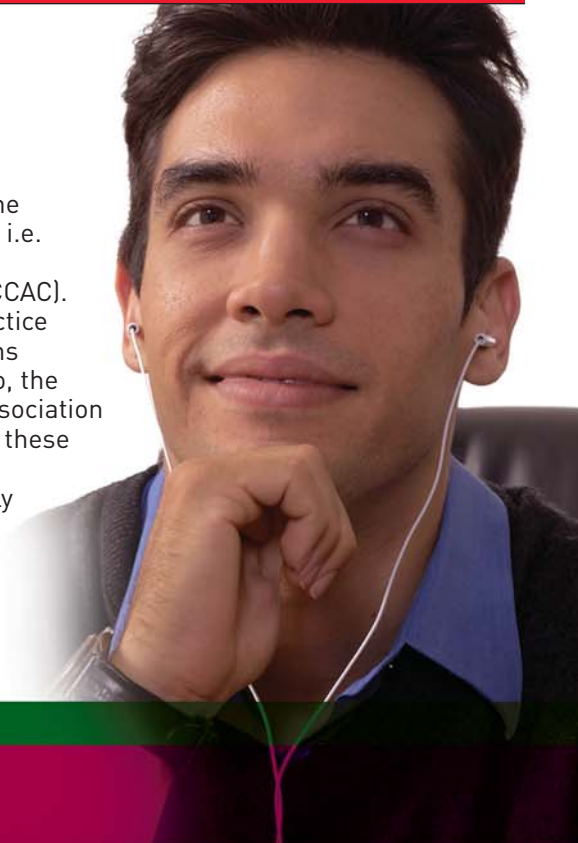
Frequently Asked Questions

What are the levels? When will I be ready?

Are they 'official' exams?

Yes: they have been accredited by the Welsh Assembly's Regulatory Body, i.e. the Qualifications, Curriculum and Assessment Authority for Wales (ACCAC). They follow the ACCAC Code of Practice and are in the National Qualifications Framework at the above levels. Also, the WJEC is a member of ALTE (The Association of Language Testers in Europe) and these exams are included in the ALTE framework. They correspond broadly to the European levels: A1-B2.
