Working with the community:

A strong link remains between the school and the local community. During the term, a lot of work has taken place with the Salvation Army Church. In November, a group of pupils spent the afternoon with an elderly group there, playing games and keeping them company. In recent weeks, the school prefects visited the church to see how the food bank works.

On September 26th, workers from Lloyds Bank came to undertake some work around the school site and we're very grateful to them for their hard work. PC Thomas often comes to school on a regular basis to hold different workshops. It was year 4 pupils' turn this term, with a workshop on stranger danger.

New Clubs:

A variety of clubs have started this term, including a Science Club, Art Club and a Woodwind choir. They are held during lunchtime. In the new year, a new Coding Club will be starting for year 5 and 6 pupils so keep your eyes open for this.

Shakespeare Performance:

Some year 5 and 6 pupils were lucky enough to be a part of 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' production which was put on in The Riverfront Theatre in Newport on November 15th. The pupils worked to prepare and they all performed excellently. Well done to everyone.

Trips:

A number of trips have been arranged this term, including the reception class trip to see CYW, year 1 and 2 trip to the Sherman Theatre, year 3 and 4 trip to Big Pit and the year 5 and 6 trip to Cilfynydd Water Centre.

We've also had many visitors to the school, including Christian Malcolm who discussed his sports academy, Evan Morgan who took our Harvest Assembly, the year 3 and 4 Techniquest workshop, the year 5 and 6 STEM workshops, the Mimosa show for KS2 pupils, Ffa La La workshops for the Foundation Phase children and year 6 pupils have enjoyed taking part in different Science workshops which have been organised by a scientist from Cardiff University.

The Welsh Language Charter:

The Welsh Language Charter work is still going strong in school. On October 26th, we held a launch to present this year's work and our targets. We're still continuing with our previous work but we're also trying to promote the status of the Welsh language in the community. A group of pupils went to carry out a survey of the use of the Welsh language in Cwmbrân town centre and we've already written to the owners asking them to consider having Welsh language signs in the centre.
