Mae dros hanner o Flwyddyn 11 wedi dychwelyd atom ac wedi dechrau ar gyrsiau Lefel A a/neu gyrsiau galwedigaethol. Mae pawb erbyn hyn wedi cyfarwyddo â threfn newydd y dydd ac o'r farn bod amser yn hedfan heibio hyd yn oed yn gynt nag o'r blaen! Mae yna nifer o ddatblygiadau cyffrous yn yr Ysgol. Rydym wedi cyflogi swyddog rygbi a ffitrwydd mewn cydweithrediad ag Undeb Rygbi Cymru ac yn edrych ymlaen at ei gyfraniad ef at iechyd a ffitrwydd yn yr ysgol. Rydym wedi danfon adroddiadau interim ar eu newydd wedd atoch fel rhieni a gobeithiwn bydd y rhain yn rhoi gwybodaeth ddefnyddiol i chi. Mae'r rhain yn mynd law yn llaw gyda'n apiau newydd Taro'r Targed (Class Charts) a Schools Gateway fel eich bod â'r wybodaeth ddiweddaraf am gyrraedd ac ymddygiad eich plentyn. Last Year's Yr 13 are now all at their Universities or embarking on the next stage of their career and well over half of last year's Year 11 have returned to us to start on their A Level and Vocational courses. There have been some exciting new developments in school: We have employed a new rugby and fitness officer in tandem with the WRU to work with pupils at all levels. Students are also now engaged in our new look school council which has seven committees looking at all aspects of school life from raising money for charity, The Welsh Language to the environment.

We welcomed the Assembly Member for Welsh and Lifelong Learning Baroness Eluned Morgan to make the announcement at school. We will now wait for the next steps in this exciting development.

I wireddu'r freuddwyd daeth Eluned Morgan i'r ysgol i gyhoeddi bod rhan o'r £46 miliwn sydd wedi cael ei glustnodi i greu ysgolion Cymraeg newydd ac ehangu ysgolion sy'n bodoli'n barod yn cael ei roi i Dor-faen i agor ysgol gynradd Gymraeg ar safle Gwynllyw.

It is the government's intention to achieve a million Welsh speakers by the year 2050. To further this aspiration Eluned Morgan visited the school to announce that part of the £46 million, earmarked to create new Welsh schools as well as to enhance the existing schools, is being provided to Torfaen to open a new Welsh Primary School on the Gwynllyw site.

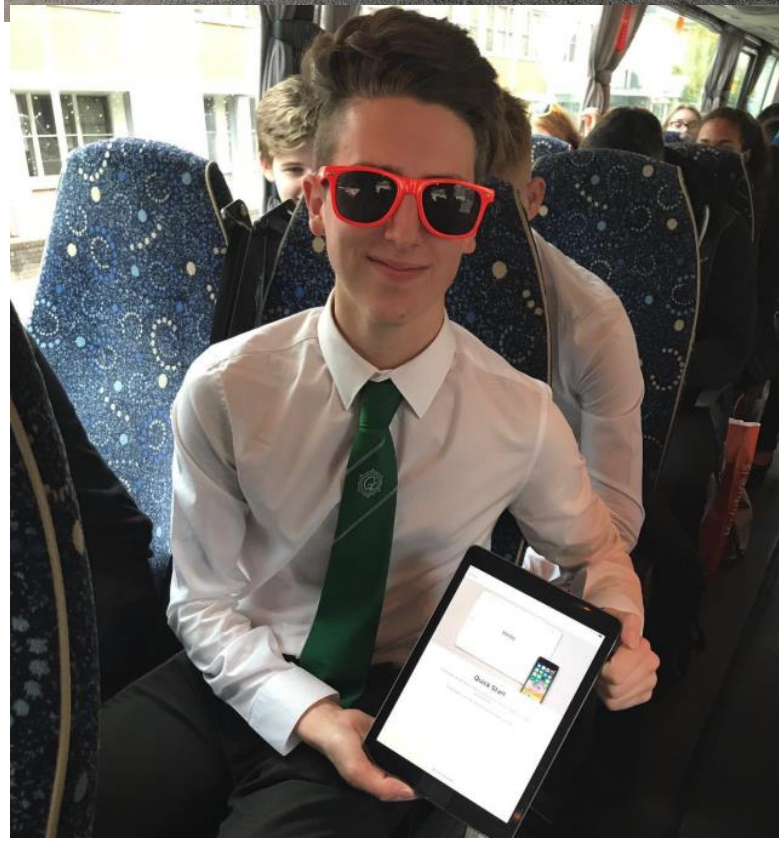

3ydd Edwards bl 7.

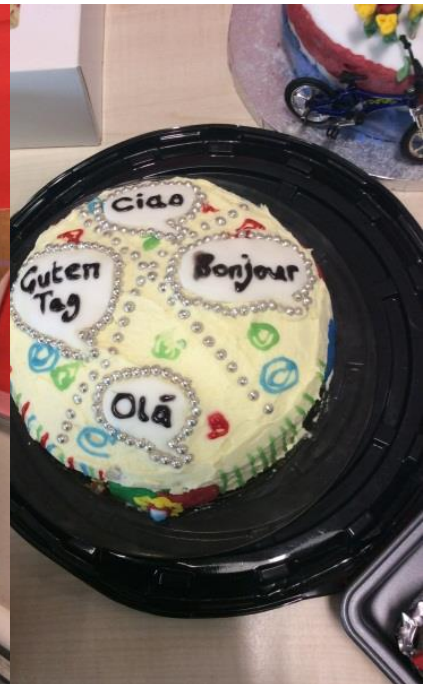
