Annwyl Riant / Warchodwr,


Dyma fwy o wybodaeth i chi ar gyfer ein taith i Gaerdydd. **Gofynnaf yn garedig am yr holl ffurflenni iechyd yn ôl erbyn dydd Llun, 2il o Fawrth os gwelwch yn dda.**

- **Byddwn yn gadael yr ysgol tua 9:30 o'r gloch ddydd Llun, 9fed o Fawrth.**
- Gall y disgyblion wisgo dillad eu hunain i'r ysgol ar y diwrnod hwnnw.
- Bydd angen pecyn bwyd ar eich plentyn ar gyfer cinio dydd Llun.
- Bydd angen dillad nos, pethau ymolchi a thywel.
- Bydd angen sach gysgu ar eich plentyn ond NID oes angen clustog.
- Bydd angen dillad cynnes ar y disgyblion, gan gynnwys côt law, sgarff, het, menig ayyb.
- Bydd angen pâr o esgidiau sy'n addas ar gyfer cerdded.
- Bydd angen 'dillad disgo' arnynt ar gyfer y nos Lun.
- Gofynnwn yn garedig i chi sicrhau bod **enw ar bob eitem**, gan gynnwys tywelion.
- Gall y disgyblion ddod â £10 i wario yn y siop yno. Byddwn yn cadw'r arian yn saff mewn loceri felly byddai'n ddelfrydol petai'r arian yn cael ei roi mewn amlen / waled gydag enw'ch plentyn arno a bod yr arian mewn punnoedd yn hytrach na phapur £10.
- Os ydy'r disgyblion yn dioddef o asthma, **rhaid** iddynt ddod â phwmp gyda nhw neu bydd angen llythyr yn egluro pam nad oes un gyda nhw. Gwnewch yn siŵr bod enw ar y pwmp asthma os gwelwch yn dda.
- Os oes unrhyw foddion gyda'ch plentyn, gan gynnwys tabledi teithio, rhaid sicrhau bod rhain yn cael eu rhoi i fi ar y bore dydd Llun. (Rhaid sicrhau bod enw ar bob eitem a bod llythyr yn esbonio beth i'w wneud a phryd i roi'r moddion, wedi'i lofnodi gan riant / warchodwr.)
- Does dim hawl gan unrhyw un i ddod â 'straightners' gyda nhw i Gaerdydd.
- Does dim angen ffonau symudol na iPods ayyb chwaith.
- Byddwn yn gadael Caerdydd am tua 2 o'r gloch ddydd Mawrth felly byddwn ni'n ôl erbyn diwedd y dydd.

Cardiff Trip (9th-10th of March):

Dear Parent / Guardian,

Here is some more information about the overnight stay in Cardiff. Please ensure that all medical forms are sent back by Monday, 2nd of March please.

- We will be leaving the school at about 9:30 on Monday the 9th of March.
- The pupils can wear their own clothes to school on that day.
- Pupils will need a packed lunch for the Monday.
- Pupils will need pyjamas/night clothes, washing items and a towel.
- Pupils will need a sleeping bag but will NOT NEED a pillow.
- Pupils will need warm clothes, including a rain coat, scarf, hat, gloves etc.
- Pupils will need comfortable shoes suitable for walking.
- Pupils will need 'disco clothes' for the Monday evening.
- We ask you kindly to ensure that there is a **name on each item** of clothing, including towel.
- Pupils can bring £10 with them to spend in the shop there. We will keep the money safe in a locker so ideally, pupils should put the money in a money bag / wallet with their name on it. Pound coins rather than a £10 note please.
- If your child suffers from asthma, he/she must bring their pump or a letter stating why they haven't got their pump. Please ensure that there is a name on each pump.
- If your child has any medicine, including travel sickness tablets, please ensure that these are handed to me on the Monday morning. Again, please ensure that there is a name on each item along with a letter explaining when to give the medicine, signed by a parent / guardian.
- Straighteners are not allowed.
- No mobile phones or ipods etc are allowed.
- We will be leaving Cardiff at around 2 o'clock on the Tuesday so we will be back in school by the end of the school day.

If you haven't already done so, the remainder of the money will need to be paid by Wednesday, 4th of March. If you have any further questions about the trip, please contact me at the school.
