Dear **Nursery Parent / Guardian,**

The Welsh Government have announced that the second phase of reopening schools will see the return of Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to 6) pupils on the 15th March 2021. We would like to inform you now of some further necessary changes to our usual arrangements. These will have to be implemented to comply with the recently updated operational guidance issued by Welsh Government.

All teaching staff are entitled to planning, preparation, and assessment time each week. Usually we provide this by using additional teachers who move between classes to release staff. Under the current guidance it is not advisable to do this as these staff would be crossing several contact groups. To facilitate this release time safely, the Nursery will close to pupils every other Friday starting on Friday 19th March. On alternate Fridays, the school will revert to distance learning and work will be provided for pupils on our learning platform

This approach has now been implemented by many schools across the authority.

Here are the dates when the Nursery will be **closed:**

Friday 19<sup>th</sup> March

Friday 16<sup>th</sup> April

Friday 30<sup>th</sup> April

Friday 14<sup>th</sup> May

Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May

Friday 18<sup>th</sup> June

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July

**On the Fridays when the Nursery is open, parents who also have a child in the main school, should collect their child from Nursery at 12pm before making their way down the ramp to collect their older children from the middle yard at 12:10pm.**

If the situation regarding the crossing of contact groups changes, we will of course review this and look to return to our usual arrangements.
