



Negeseuon allweddol i gymuned yr ysgol / Key messages for the school community

- TREFNIADAU GOLLWNG A CHASGLU** - Y ddwy gât naill ochr i'r brif gât yw'r prif fynediad i safle'r ysgol. Gall disgyblion Blynnyddoedd 3-6 ddefnyddio'r gât ar bwys maes parcio'r staff yn y bore, os ydynt yn dynuno. **Dylai plant Blynnyddoedd 3-6 gerdded yn annibynnol i'w dosbarthiadau o'r gatiau.** Bydd sawl aelod o staff ar ddyletswydd i orchwylia'r disgyblion wrth iddynt gerdded i'w dosbarthiadau. Meithrin i ddefnyddio'r gatiau dwbl y tu ôl i adeilad y Feithrin wrth gyrraedd ac ar ddiwedd eu sesiwn.
- AMSEROEDD YSGOL** - Bydd angen i ddisgyblion gyrraedd rhwng **8:45am a 8:55am** - i sicrhau bod pob disgybl yn y dosbarth erbyn 9:00yb. Dylid casglu teuluoedd o'r iard ganol am 3:15pm. Cesglir pob disgybl nad oes ganddo frawd neu chwaer yn yr ysgol am 3:25pm. Dylid casglu disgyblion ym Mlynnyddoedd 3-6 o'r iard ganol a dylid casglu'r disgyblion hynny yn y Dosbarthiadau Derbyn i Flwyddyn 2 o'r ardaloedd dynodedig ym mlaen yr ysgol.
- GWISG YMARFER CORFF** - Dylai'r disgyblion ddod i'r ysgol yn eu gwisg Ymarfer Corff ar y diwrnodau mae ganddynt wersi Ymarfer Corff. (Manylion am ba ddiwrnodau wedi eu rhannu ar Schoop eisioes.)
- CINIO YSGOL** - Rheni/Gwarcheidwaid plant y Derbyn i Flwyddyn 2 - Cofiwch lenwi'r ffurflen am ginio rhad. (Mae'r ddolen wedi ei rhannu eisioes).
- CYFATHREBU EFFEITHIOL** - Bydd bron pob gohebiaeth yn cael ei ddanfon drwy Schoop. Sicrhewch eich bod wedi lawrlwytho'r ap a newid y gosodiadau i ddilyn y dosbarth/dosbarthiadau perthnasol. - LABELU GWISG YSGOL** - Sicrhewch bod holl wisg ysgol eich plentyn/plant wedi'i labelu. Bydd hwn yn ein cynorthwyo'n fawr i'ch helpu i ddod o hyd i eitemau coll!
- COVID** - Mae'r canllawiau diweddaraf yn nodi y dylai eich plentyn aros gartref os oes ganddo brif symptomau Covid (Tymheredd 37.8 neu uwch, peswch cyson newydd neu golled o synnwyr o flas neu arogl neu sylwi ar newid ynddo). Gallant ddychwelyd i'r ysgol pan nad oes ganddynt dymheredd uchel mwyach ac maent yn ddigon da i fynychu.

DIOLCH YN FAWR IAWN I CHI GYD AM EICH CYDWEITHREDIAD.

- DROP OFF AND COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS** - The two gates adjacent to the main gate are the main points of entry to the school site. Pupils in Years 3-6 can enter the site in the morning via the gate by the staff car park, if they wish. **Pupils in Years 3-6 should walk independently to their classes from the gates. Several members of staff are on duty to supervise the pupils as they walk to their classes.** Nursery should enter and leave the site via the double gates behind the Nursery building.
- SCHOOL TIMES** - Pupils will need to arrive between **8:45am and 8:55am** - to ensure that all pupils are in class by 9:00am. Families should be collected from the middle yard at 3:15pm. All pupils who do not have a sibling in the school will be collected at 3:25pm. Pupils in Years 3-6 should be collected from the middle yard and those pupils in Reception to Year 2 should be collected from the designated areas at the front of the school.
- P.E. KIT** - Pupils should attend school in their PE kit on the days they have PE lessons. (Details have been sent via Schoop.)
- SCHOOL LUNCHES** - Parents/Guardians of children in Reception to Year 2 - Remember to complete the Universal Free School meal form. (A link has been sent previously via Schoop).
- EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION** - Almost all correspondence will be sent via Schoop. Please ensure that you have downloaded the app and changed the settings to follow the relevant class/classes. - LABELLING SCHOOL UNIFORM** - Please ensure that your child/children's uniform is labelled. This will assist us greatly to help you reclaim any lost items!
- COVID** - The most recent guidance states that your child should stay at home if they have the main symptoms of Covid (Temperature 37.8 or above, new continuous cough or loss or change of taste or smell). They can return to school when they no longer have a high temperature and are well enough to attend.
