## **Prydau Ysgol**

Estynnwyd y cynnig prydau ysgol am ddim i bob disgybl y flwyddyn academaidd hon. Bob dydd mae ganddynt ddewis o bryd poeth cig neu lysieuol neu stondin salad/pasta.

Wrth gyflwyno'r Clwb Brecwast ym mis Medi 2023, mae gan bob disgybl o'r Dosbarth Derbyn i Flwyddyn 6 y nawr yr opsiwn o gael brecwast iach. Mae'n agor am 8:15am ac mae'r nifer sy'n mynchu yn amrywio o ddydd i ddydd.

## **School Meals**

*The universal free school meals offer was extended to all pupils this academic year. Each day they have the choice of a meat or vegetarian hot meal or salad/pasta bar.*

*The introduction of the Breakfast Club in September 2023 offers all pupils from Reception to Year 6 the option to have a healthy breakfast. It opens at 8:15am and the number who attend varies from day to day.*

Rydym yn monitro presenoldeb y disgyblion yn ofalus drwy gydol y flwyddyn. Mae'r ysgol yn parhau i osod pwyslais mawr ar gynyddu lefelau presenoldeb disgyblion. Rydym yn gweithredu'n gyson er mwyn gwneud hynny ac mae strategaethau penodol yn dwyn ffrwyth. Gweithiwn yn agos gyda'r swyddog lles er mwyn cefnogi disgyblion a'u rhieni i ddatblygu patrymau presenoldeb llwyddiannus. Ni fydd gwyliau yn ystod y tymor ysgol yn cael eu hawdurdodi os yw presenoldeb disgybl yn isel, maent yn effeithio ar gynnydd disgybl ac yn atal yr ysgol rhag cyrraedd ei tharged presenoldeb. Y Pennaeth sydd ag hawl i awdurdodi absenoldebau a gellir ddod o hyd i fwy o wybodaeth ym mholfis presenoldeb yr ysgol.

*We monitor attendance carefully throughout the year. The school continues to put great emphasis on raising attendance levels. The school has developed many strategies to improve the levels of attendance and works closely with the Education Welfare Officer. Holidays booked during the school term will not be authorised if a pupil's attendance is low, they impact on a pupil's progress and prevent the school from reaching its attendance target. Authorising absences is at the discretion of the headteacher, and further information can be found in the school's attendance policy.*

## **Iaith yr Ysgol**

Mae'r ysgol yn ysgol gyfrwng y Gymraeg. Mae'r holl wersi yn cael eu cynnal drwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen. Yng Nghyfnod Allweddol 2 cyflwynir Saesneg ac mae disgyblion yn cael eu haddysgu drwy'r ddau gyfrwng, ond yn bennaf yn y Gymraeg.

### **Language of the School**

The school is a Welsh Medium School. The Foundation Phase receive all their learning experiences through the medium of Welsh. English is introduced in Key Stage 2 and the pupils are taught through both mediums but predominantly in Welsh.

### **Datblygu'r Cwricwlwm**

Mae ein cwricwlwm yn parhau i esblygu. Mae'r dull thematig yn galluogi disgyblion i ddatblygu eu sgiliau ar draws pob maes dysgu. Dewiswyd y themâu'n ofalus sef Mudo, Dewrder a Newidiadau. Fodd bynnag, mae'r angen i sicrhau bod ein disgyblion yn gwbl ddwyieithog a'r un mor hyderus yn y Gymraeg a'r Saesneg yn golygu bod yn rhaid inni barhau i roi'r pwyslais mwyaf ar ddatblygu eu sgiliau iaith. Ein nod yw meithrin dysgwyr chwifrydig, uchelgeisiol a galluog sy'n gallu trosglwyddo eu sgiliau'n hawdd i bob maes dysgu.

Mae'r dull thematig hefyd yn addas ar gyfer cynnwys diwrnodau/wythnosau penodol e.e. Wythnos Cerdded a Beicio i'r ysgol, wythnosau Lles, Wythnos Dysgu yn yr Awyr Agored, Gwneud i £5 dyfu 'Show racism the red card', heriau noddedig, Wythnos Gwyddoniaeth, Diwrnod Siarter Iaith Seren a Sbarc a llawer mwy. Bellach gwneir mwy o ddefnydd o dir yr ysgol ac mae hwn yn faes y byddwn yn parhau i'w ddatblygu wrth symud ymlaen. Mae llais y disgybl yn parhau i fod yn rhan annatod o gynllunio profiadau dysgu.

### **The Curriculum**

*Our curriculum continues to evolve. A theme-based approach allows pupils to develop their skills across all areas of learning. The themes were carefully chosen and these Migration, Bravery ad Changes. However, the need to ensure our pupils are fully bilingual and equally confident in both Welsh and English means that we must continue to place an emphasis on developing their language skills. Our aim is to foster inquisitive, ambitious, and capable learners who can transfer their skills easily to all areas of learning.*

*The thematic approach also lends itself to the inclusion of distinct days/weeks e.g. Big Walk and Wheel week, Wellbeing weeks, Learning in the Outdoors week, Make £5 grow, Show racism the red card, sponsored challenges, Science week, Seren and Sbarc Siarter Iaith Day and many more. Greater use is now made of the school grounds, and this is an area which we will continue to develop moving forward. Pupil voice remains integral to planning learning experiences.*

### **Asesu – Cadw cofnodion a chyflwyno gwybodaeth**

Mae asesu ar gyfer dysgu yn ganolog i weithred effeithiol y cwricwlwm.

Yn Ysgol Gymraeg Cwmbrân yr ydym yn awyddus i'r asesu fod yn ddull effeithiol a gweithredol o gofnodi cynydd unigolion.

Yn ystod y flwyddyn 'rydym wedi

1. Defnyddio arddull drylwyr o farcio cau'r bwlc.
2. Datblygu systemau cyd-safoni mewnol a rhwng y Cyfnodau.
3. Sicrhau bod asesu ar gyfer dysgu yn flaenllaw ym mhob gwers.

Sicrhawyd bod yr adroddiadau ysgrifenedig i rieni yn cynnwys sylwadau am gyflawniad, ynghyd â sylwadau ar ymdrech ac agwedd ac yn cyfeirio at gynnydd y disgyblion yn unol â'r fframwaith llythrennedd a rhifedd a'r Fframwaith Cymhwysedd Digidol. Rydym yn cynnal tair noson rieni y flwyddyn er mwyn rhoi cyfre i rieni i siarad ag athro'r dosbarth eu plant ac i drafod gwaith eu plant. Yn ychwanegol, cynhelir 'Diwrnodau Agored' i gynnig cymorth i rieni ar sut i helpu eu plant.

Mae'r ysgol wedi sefydlu dull o weithredu ym maes ADY sydd yn ymateb i ofynion y ddeddf newydd.

### **Assessment – Record keeping and Reporting**

*Assessment is central to the effective implementation of the curriculum.*

*Our aim is for assessment to be an effective and practical way of ensuring and recording progress in the national curriculum.*

*During the year we*

1. *Used a thorough and consistent approach to 'closing the gap' marking.*
2. *Developed the internal and cross key stage moderating systems.*
3. *Ensured that assessment for learning is at the forefront of each lesson.*

*Efforts are made to ensure that written reports to parents contain comments of achievement in all national curriculum subjects along with the individual's progress in relation to the national literacy and numeracy framework and Digital Competency Framework as well as comments on efforts and attitude. We hold three parents' evenings per school year to give parents the opportunity to speak to their child's class teacher and discuss their child's work. In addition, open days are held to offer guidance to parents on how best to support their child's learning.*

*The school has established robust policies and procedures for ALN which respond to the requirements of the new act and legislation.*

#### **Meithrin – Blwyddyn 2/Nursery to Year 2**

Bu'r cwricwlwm ar gyfer ein dysgwyr iau yn parhau i esblygu gyda llais y disgybl a themâu eang yn galluogi y disgyblion i fwynhau ac elwa'n fawr o ystod o brofiadau gwerthfawr. Rhoddwyd llawer o bwyslais ar brofiadau dysgu ymarferol.

Fel rhan o'u testun 'Mudo', fe wnaeth disgyblion Blwyddyn 2 fwynhau plotio taith y 'nico', adeiladu blychau nythu unigol, adeiladu nythod ac ymweld â'r ardal goediog leol i chwilio am yr adar sy'n byw yno.

Cafodd disgyblion Blwyddyn 1 ddealltwriaeth well o'u hardal leol trwy ymweld â'r gamlas i arsylwi'r bywyd gwylt. Buont yn plannu coed a phlanhigion a dysgu sut i ofalu am ardd yr ysgol. Uchafbwynt i lawer o'r disgyblion oedd cloddio am esgryn deinosor yng ngardd wylt yr ysgol. Roedd hyn ynghyd â gwers gan yr Amgueddfa Genedlaethol ar ddeinosoriaid yn tanio diddordeb y disgyblion ac fe wnaethant fwynhau'r testun yn fawr.

Cafodd ein dysgwyr ieuengaf yn y Feithrin amrywiaeth eang o gyfleoedd dysgu ymarferol. Datblygon nhw eu sgiliau Cymraeg sylfaenol wrth flasu bwydydd, cymysgu lliwiau, arbrofi gyda magnetau, dŵr a thoes. Fe wnaethon nhw fwynhau'n fawr ddysgu am bobl sy'n ein helpu ni ac archarwyr fel rhan o'r thema 'Dewrder'.

I gyfoethogi'r cwricwlwm ymhellach, cawsom lawer o ymwelwyr ac ymwelliadau. Roedd y rhain yn cynnwys taith i Sainsbury's, bore coffi llwyddiannus iawn i Deidiau a Nain a sgwrs gan aelod o Erddi Cymunedol y Goetre ar wenyna. Cafodd y disgyblion fudd o deithiau i'r Senedd a Techniquest.

Drwy gydol y flwyddyn, bu plant y Cyfnod Sylfaen yn ddigon ffodus i gael gwersi wythnosol o 'Torfaen Music'. Unwaith eto eleni, cafodd plant blwyddyn 2 wersi ffidil am ddim gan 'Gerddoriaeth Gwent' a braf oedd eu gweld yn perfformio i'w teuluoedd ar ddiwedd eu gwersi.

Cipolwg yn unig yw hwn o'r llu o brofiadau dysgu amrywiol sydd wedi'u trefnu ar gyfer y disgyblion. Mae cyfrif X yn llwyfan gwych i weld sut mae ein disgyblion yn datblygu eu sgiliau ym mhob maes o'r cwricwlwm ac mewn cymaint o amgylcheddau gwahanol.

*The curriculum for our younger learners continued to evolve with pupil voice and broad themes allowing pupils to enjoy and benefit greatly from a range of learning experiences. Much emphasis was placed on practical learning experiences.*

*As part of their 'Migration' topic, Year 2 pupils thoroughly enjoyed plotting the journey of the 'nico', building individual nestboxes, building nests and visiting the local wooded area to look for the birds who reside there.*

*Year 1 pupils gained a better understanding of their local area by visiting the canal to observe the wildlife. They planted both trees and plants and learned how to care for the school garden. A highlight for many of the pupils was excavating for dinosaur bones in the wild garden area of the school. This coupled with a lesson by the National Museum on dinosaurs ignited the interest of the pupils and they thoroughly enjoyed the topic.*

*Our very youngest learners in the Nursery were provided with a vast array of practical learning opportunities. They developed their basic Welsh language skills when tasting foods, mixing colours, experimenting with magnets, water and dough. They thoroughly enjoyed their learning about people who help us and superheroes as part of the 'Bravery' topic.*

*To enrich the curriculum further, we had many visitors and visits. These included a trip to Sainsbury's, a very successful coffee morning for Grandparents and a talk by a member of the Goytre Community Gardens on beekeeping. Pupils benefited from trips to the Senedd and Techniquest.*

*Throughout the year, the Foundation Phase children were lucky enough to experience weekly lessons from 'Torfaen Music'. Once again this year, year 2 children received free violin lessons from 'Gwent Music' and it was lovely to see them perform to their families at the end of their lessons.*

*This is just a snapshot of the many varied learning experiences that have been arranged for the pupils. The X account is a great platform to see how our pupils develop their skills in all areas of the curriculum and in so many different environments.*

### **Blynnyddoedd 3-6**

Datblygu'r disgyblion yn ddysgwyr annibynnol oedd yr egwyddor allweddol pan oedd staff yn cynllunio'r themâu a'r profiadau dysgu eleni. Mae pob thema yn dechrau gyda sesiynau rhagarweiniol lle mae disgyblion a staff yn cydweithio i gynllunio'r dysgu dilynol.

'Mudo' oedd thema gyntaf y flwyddyn. Ymwelodd cwmni theatr 'Mewn Cymeriad' i gyfleo storï'r Mimosa i'r disgyblion. Roedd y thema hon hefyd yn addas ar gyfer gwaith ymchwil gan y ddisgyblion i bam mae rhoi anifeiliaid ac adar yn mudo. Ar ôl dysgu mwy am rai adar, gwnaeth y disgyblion bwydydd adar a thynnu llun y rhai sy'n mudo.

Fel rhan o'r thema 'Dewrder', dysgodd disgyblion am ffigurau yn hanes Cymru a gafodd effaith oherwydd eu dewrder a'u credoau e.e. Betsi Cadwaladr a Nye Bevan. Roedd datblygu sgiliau TGCh y disgyblion yn flaenllaw yn y cynllunio a mwynhaodd disgyblion Blwyddyn 6 gynllunio algorithm a chynhyrchu gwefan ar y thema hon. Sicrhawyd cyllid gan Gyngor Celfyddydau Cymru i rai o'n disgyblion Blwyddyn 5 a 6 ddatblygu eu sgiliau celf fyngiannol yn ystod y thema 'Hunaniaeth'. Fel rhan o brosiect tymor, cafodd y disgyblion gyfle i sgrin-brintio, argraffu crys T, dysgu mwy am fod yn 'DJ', ymweld â cherflun Betty Campbell a'r Amgueddfa Genedlaethol a gwyllo perfformiad gan gwmni theatr Mewn Cymeriad am Betty Campbell.

'Newidiadau' oedd e'n thema olaf am y flwyddyn a

Mae disgyblion wedi derbyn gwersi cerdd dosbarth cyfan gan Cerdd Torfaen. Cafodd disgyblion blwyddyn 3/4 gyfle i ddysgu sut i chwarae'r glockenspiel a chwiban geiniog. Datblygodd disgyblion blwyddyn 5/6 eu sgiliau cerddorol wrth ddysgu'r delyn a'r ukelele. Bu disgyblion Blwyddyn 6 yn cymryd rhan mewn prosiect pontio llwyddiannus iawn gydag ysgolion eraill clwstwr Gwynnlyw a gydlynwyd gyda 'Upbeat Music'. Derbyniodd ein disgyblion Blwyddyn 6 wersi ar y drymiau djembe a pherfformio gyda'u cyfoedion mewn cyngerdd yng Nghanolfan Dysgu Gweithredol Pont-y-pŵl ar ddiwedd y flwyddyn academaidd.

Trefnwyd tair taith breswyl yn ystod y flwyddyn. Treuliodd Blwyddyn 4 y noson yng Nghanolfan yr Urdd ym Mae Caerdydd, Blwyddyn 5 am ddua ddiwrnod yng Nghanolfan Aml-weithgaredd Llangors a Blwyddyn 6 yn ymweld â Gwersyll yr Urdd Llangrannog am y penwythnos.

Eto, ciplun yn unig yw hwn o'r llu o brofiadau dysgu amrywiol sydd wedi'u trefnu ar gyfer y disgyblion. Cymerwch olwg ar gyfrif X i weld sut mae ein disgyblion yn datblygu eu sgiliau ym mhob maes o'r wricwlwm ac mewn cymaint o amgylcheddau gwahanol.

### **Years 3-6**

Developing the pupils as independent learners was the underlying principle when staff planned the themes and learning experiences this year. Each theme starts with introductory sessions where pupils and staff work together to plan future learning.

'Migration' was the first theme of the year. The theatre company 'Mewn Cymeriad' visited to relay the story of the Mimosa to pupils. This theme also lent itself to pupils researching why some animals and birds migrate. Upon learning more about certain birds, pupils made bird feeders and drew those which migrate.

As part of the 'Bravery' theme, pupils learnt about figures in Welsh history who made an impact due to their bravery and beliefs e.g. Betsi Cadwaladr and Nye Bevan. Developing the pupils' ICT skills was at the forefront of planning and Year 6 pupils enjoyed planning an algorithm and producing a website on this theme.

'Changes' was our final theme and pupils developed their understanding of climate change, changes to the welsh landscape and changes to the body.

Funding was secured from the Arts Council of Wales for some of our Year 5 and 6 pupils to develop their expressive art skills during the 'Identity' theme. As part of a term long project pupils had the opportunity to screen print, print a T-shirt, learn more about Djing, visit the Betty Campbell statue and National Museum and to watch a performance by the Mewn Cymeriad theatre company about Betty Campbell.

Pupils have received whole class music lessons from Cerdd Torfaen. Year 3/4 pupils had the opportunity to learn how to play the glockenspiel and penny whistle. Year 5/6 pupils developed their musical skills when learning the harp and ukelele. Year 6 pupils took part in a very successful transition project with the other schools in the Gwynllwy cluster which was coordinated with 'Upbeat Music'. Our Year 6 pupils received lessons on the djembe drums and performed along with their peers in a concert at the Pontypool Active Learning Centre at the end of the academic year.

Three residential trips were organised during the year. Year 4 spent the night at the Urdd Centre in Cardiff Bay, Year 5 spent two days at the Llangorse Multi Activity Centre and Year 6 visited the Urdd Camp at Llangrannog for the weekend.

### **Cynllun mynediad i'r ysgol**

Rydym yn sicrhau bod pob plentyn ag anabledd yn cael yr un profiadau â phawb arall yn yr ysgol. Rydym yn gwerthuso ein perfformiad yn gyson er mwyn sicrhau ein bod yn gwrdd â gofynion pob plentyn.

Mae rampiau y tu mewn a thu allan i'r adeilad yn sicrhau bod disgyblion a rhieni gydag anabledd yn gallu cael mynediad i bob rhan o'r adeilad.

Mae tŷ bach sydd hefyd yn addas ar gyfer disgyblion ag anableddau o fewn yr adeilad. Mae ardaloedd sydd â nifer o dai bach yn rhan o bob dosbarth. Mae'r gofalwr a'r glanhauwyr yn sicrhau eu bod yn lân ac yn ddiogel. Mae hyn yn cael ei wirio yn ddyddiol. Mae'r staff dysgu hefyd yn atgoffa'r disgyblion am bwysigrwydd hylendid personol.

### **School Accessibility Plan**

*As a school we ensure that good quality learning through good quality teaching and support is provided by all in the school. We ensure that all pupils with a disability have the same experiences as everyone else. We evaluate our performance regularly to ensure that we are meeting the needs of each pupil.*

*There are ramps inside the building and a toilet that is suitable for the needs of those with a disability. Toilets are located in every classroom area. They are cleaned and monitored for cleanliness on a daily basis by the cleaning staff and the school caretaker. The teaching staff also remind the pupils about the importance of personal hygiene.*

### **Iechyd a Lles**

Mae lles ein disgyblion wrth wraidd pob dim rydym yn ei wneud ac yn sail i'n cwricwlwm newydd. Mae'n hollbwysig i ni sicrhau bod y disgyblion yn cael digon o wybodaeth am y cymorth a'r asiantaethau sydd ar gael iddynt. Mae prynhawniau lles wedi'u hamserleni ar gyfer bob prynhawn dydd Mercher. Rhoddir pwyslais ar anghenion y disgyblion a defnyddir llyfrau penodol fel sbardun i'r gwaith. Darparir cymorth ychwanegol i grwpiau targed. Mae'r cymorth yma'n cynnwys sesiynau COMiT, Cwnsela a chefnogaeth benodol i'n gofalwyr ifanc.

Mae gan yr ysgol bolisi 'dŵr wrth y ddesg' ac rydym yn sicrhau ein bod yn achub pob cyfle i hyrwyddo bwyta diet cytbwys. Mae'r staff yn cynnal clybiau ffitrwydd allgyrsiol wythnosol ac mae gan bob dosbarth dwy sesiwn llythrennedd corfforol ar yr amserlen bob wythnos. Rydym wedi cynyddu'r cyfleoedd i ddysgu yn yr awyr agored ac yn gweithio gydag asiantaethau allanol i ddatblygu'r ddarpariaeth yma ymhellach.

## **Health and Wellbeing**

*Our pupils' wellbeing is at the heart of all that we do and forms the basis of our new curriculum. It is important that our pupils are aware of the support and of the many agencies which are available to them. Weekly wellbeing afternoons are timetabled for each Wednesday afternoon. An emphasis is placed on the needs of our pupils and specific books are used as a focus for these sessions. Additional support is provided for target groups. This support includes COMiT sessions, Counselling, and specific support for our young carers.*

*The school has a 'water at desk' policy and ensures that every opportunity is taken to promote the importance of a balanced diet. The staff run extra curricular fitness clubs weekly and each class has two physical literacy sessions timetabled per week. We have increased the opportunities for pupils to learn in the outdoors and we continue to work with external agencies to further develop this provision.*

## **Deddf Cyfartaledd**

Mae'n ddyletswydd ar yr ysgol i hyrwyddo cydraddoldeb. Mae ein cynllun cydraddoldeb ysgol yn amlinellu ein blaenorriaethau. Mae'n ofynnol i ysgolion baratoi a chyhoeddi Cynllun Cydraddoldeb Strategol ac amcanion cydraddoldeb pwrrpasol (unwaith bob pedair blynedd). Gellir dod o hyd i hwn ar wefan yr ysgol.

*The Police, Road Safety Officers, Fire Safety Team, Knauff Insulation, Newport County, Upbeat and Cerdd Torfaen work with us to provide further valuable learning experiences for the pupils.*

*The school and the colleges continue with the partnership agreement with The University of South Wales, Newport University, Cardiff University and Ysgol Gyfun Gwynllwyd. This means that the school has a regular intake of students. The scheme is working very effectively for both the school and colleges. The school has developed effective relationships with the other schools within our cluster.*

*We have developed a very effective partnership with The Care Collective, The Salvation Army, Zero Waste Torfaen, CCYP and CAMHS.*
