### Getting Started with Bluesky: A Quick Guide

#### 1. Creating Your Account:

- Download the Bluesky app from the App Store or Google Play, or visit the Bluesky website.
- Click on the "Sign Up" button.
- Enter your email address, create a password, and provide your date of birth.
- Choose a user handle.

#### 2. Navigating the Interface:

- **Home Feed:** Shows posts from people you follow.
- **Discover Feed:** Displays content based on your interests.
- **Notifications:** Keeps you updated on interactions with your posts.

#### 3. Posting and Interacting:

- To create a post, click on the "Compose" button, write your message, and click "Post."
- You can like, comment, and share posts just like on X.

#### 4. Managing Your Account:

- Access your settings to update your profile, manage privacy options, and customise notifications.

To follow events and news from the school, simply search **Ysgol Gymraeg Cwmbran** once you have set up your own account.
