

What is the Disabled Children's Index?

The Disabled Children's Index is a confidential list of children and young people (aged 0-18) with disabilities or additional needs living in Torfaen. It helps the local authority and partner agencies to:

- Plan and improve local services for disabled children and their families
- Share important information about support and activities available
- Ensure families are informed about their rights and entitlements.

Who Can Join the Index?

Your child can be included if they have a disability, additional support need,

or long-term health condition that significantly impacts their daily life. This could include:

- · Physical disabilities
- · Learning disabilities
- Autism or neurodevelopmental conditions
- Sensory impairments (hearing or vision loss)
- Long-term medical conditions

Joining the Index is voluntary and does not affect eligibility for services or benefits.

Why Should You Register?

By joining the Index, you will:

 Receive up-to-date information about local services, events, and support groups

 Help shape services by providing valuable feedback about your child's

needs.

How is Your Information Used?

- The information is kept confidential and secure
- It is used only for planning and improving services not for assessments or referrals
- You can request to update or remove your details at any time.

How to Register?
