Pori Drwy Stori - Nursery programme:

Pori Drwy Stori is an exciting, bilingual programme aimed at encouraging a love of books, stories and rhymes and it supports children to develop speaking, listening and numeracy skills.

The Pori Drwy Stori programme aims to improve educational outcomes for children in Nursery. The programme provides resources for use in the classroom and at home, encouraging parents/ guardians to continue in their vital role as partners in their children's learning. The programme has been designed and delivered by Booktrust Cymru and is funded by the Welsh Government. Two of the main aims of the programme are:

- To improve oracy related outcomes, and
- To increase parents'/carers' engagement with their child's learning.

There are two main elements to the plan, 'It's rhyme time' and 'Talk about a book'. The first element is 'It's rhyme time'. Under different conditions, the set of resources would be going home and coming back weekly. Unfortunately, under current conditions this is not possible and therefore all the resources are in the enclosed package.

Despite that, we will be learning one nursery rhyme weekly so, if possible, keep to the weekly routine (1-5) for the nursery rhymes.
